About Hidden Hollow Camp

Rustic cabins are the summer homes of campers. The cabins are located in two camps - one for the boys and one for the girls. In addition to the 12 log-sided cabins, there are two dorm-sized cabins that house their own rest room facilities. There are rest rooms and washing facilities in both camps. **Cost \$15.00 per night.** Please bring your own linens, towels, toiletries, sleeping bag, etc.

Coming from the North or Northwest:

Take Ohio route 13 south through Mansfield - on south side of Mansfield Ohio Rte 13 passes under I-71 - the next road to the left is O'Possum Run Road (stop light at intersection). Following O'Possum Run Road for 6.2 miles -Hidden Hollow Camp (large sign) will be on the left (east) - a Marathon station is across the road from the camp Follow the camp road to the end - parking will be at the end of the road. Signs will direct you to the Conference Building.

Coming from the Northeast:

Take the exit for Ohio Route 13 - turn left onto Ohio Rte 13 south. - Route 13 passes under I-71.- the first road to the left is O'Possum Run Road (stop light at intersection). Following O'Possum Run Road for 6.2 miles - Hidden Hollow Camp (large sign) will be on the left (east) - a Marathon station is across the road from the camp Follow the camp road to the end - parking will be at the end of the road. Signs will direct you to the Conference Building.

Coming from Southwest on I-71:

Take Ohio Route 13 exit - turn left on to Route 13 - first road to the right (at stop light) will be O'Possum Run Rd - Following O'Possum Run Road for 6.2 miles -Hidden Hollow Camp (large sign) will be on the left (east) - a Marathon station is across the road from the camp Follow the camp road to the end - parking will be at the end of the road. Signs will direct you to the Conference Building.

Coming from the South on Ohio Route 13:

Take Ohio Rte 97 east out of Bellville (towards Butler). At Teeter Road turn left and follow to end at O'Possum Run Road. At O'Possum Run Road turn right - in a just a short distance (1/4 mile) will be a Marathon on the right - the Hidden Hollow Camp will be on the left. Follow the camp road to the end - parking will be at the end of the road. Signs will direct you to the Conference building.

Robert J. Koester first joined the Appalachian Search & Rescue Conference in 1981 and since then has participated in hundreds of searches. He holds a Master of Science degree in biology (neurobiology) from the University of Virginia. His contributions to search and rescue include seminal research on lost person behavior (with emphasis on dementia) and the International Search and Rescue Incident Database (ISRID). A Type 1 incident commander and instructor for the Virginia Department of Emergency Management and past president of the Virginia Search and Rescue Council (served as president for 12 years), Robert has also worked for the United States Coast Guard, National Aeronautics and Space Administration, National Park Service, and Federal Emergency Management Agency. The author of numerous books and articles on search and rescue, he is currently creating the International Journal of Search and Rescue. He has presented in Australia, Canada, Iceland, New Zealand, the United Kingdom, and throughout the United States.
